BOOKINGS & ENROLMENTS

Credit card facility is available with a \$1 or \$2 surcharge. All course prices are GST inclusive. Classes with insufficient enrolments may be cancelled or postponed. Courses require full payment for the term at the time of enrolment. Late payments may incur a 10% late fee. Concession rates are available for some courses – current Health Care Card or Centrelink Pension Card must be sighted to be eligible.

If you are away from your class or session for more than two weeks during term, please ensure you advise your tutor.

If your circumstances change and you will no longer be attending your class, please let us know as soon as possible so the space can be offered to someone else.

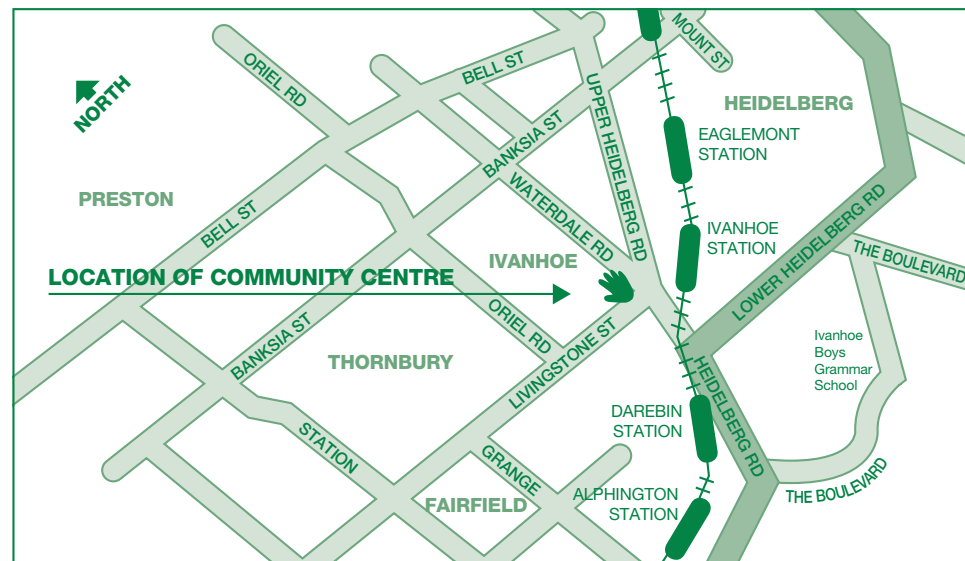
REFUNDS

Refunds will be made when a course is cancelled by LCC or when a participant withdraws up to a week before the starting date. Refunds may be given for absence due to medical reasons and upon presentation of a medical certificate.

For refunds \$50 or below, a cancellation fee of \$5 applies. For refunds over \$50, a cancellation fee equal to 10% of the refunded amount will apply.
